which will be held in conjunction with the 2015 **IACCM Academic Forum** organized by the International Association for Contract and Commercial Management (IACCM) in Henderson, NV, USA **6 October 2015**, during the **IACCM Americas Forum 2014** (see http://www.iaccm.com/amer15/) on October 6-8.

Like in previous years, the 2015 Academic Forum brings together professionals and academics from a variety of disciplines to provide a platform for knowledge exchange opening up possibilities for research collaboration and supporting closer ties between professionals and scholarly academics. If you are interested in submitting a proposal for a presentation or a paper for the Academic Forum, the deadline is **15 July 2015**. The focus of this year's event is contracting for sustainability, broadly interpreted as economics, relationships, and resources. Further, all other contract and contract management topics will be welcome. Submissions may be theoretical or empirical. Essays, case studies, experiments, field studies and state of the art reviews are all welcome. The organizers also welcome interdisciplinary research where academia and business collaborate on topics relevant to the theory and practice of contract and commercial management. Papers/presentations may be presented from a variety of disciplines, such as law, business, economics, social responsibility, finance, marketing, management, accounting, information design, management information systems, public administration, business education, and related fields.
